

Day 1 - Overnight flight (Friday 12 September)

Day 2 - Cape Town (Saturday 13 September)

Day 3 - Cape Town (Sunday 14 September) Morning Table mountain & Robben Island visit (Optional)

Table Mountain is the most renowned historical sightseeing landmark in all of South Africa. It is likewise the most photographed attraction in Cape Town for it's famous flat-top and has seen millions of visitors

Table Mountain since 1994 has become the world's icon of South African pride and democracy for locals and travellers.

Robben Island has been used as a prison and a place where people were isolated, banished and exiled to for nearly 400 years. It was also used as a post office, a grazing ground, a mental hospital and an outpost. Learn about the Island's role as a former prison, and hear stories about Nelson Mandela and how he spent 18 years of his 27-year sentence there.

Day 4 - Cape Town (Monday 15 September) Morning Golf at Paarl Golf Course

Paarl Golf Club is rich in history and counts as one of the oldest golf clubs in South Africa. Royal Cape Golf Club is the oldest club in South Africa established in 1886. An interesting fact is that golf only started in the United States of America a year later in 1887! Paarl Golf Club was established in 1908 and started off with a nine-hole "links" type of course next to the Berg River in the "middle" of the current town known as Sanddrift. This design was done by the well-known golf architect Bob Grimsdell. The course became too small for the demand and was eventually shifted to Suider-Paarl (the current location) in 1955 where an 18-hole course was constructed again along the banks of the Berg River. **https://www.boschenmeerestate.co.za**/

Day 6 - Cape Town (Wednesday 17 September)


Full Day Franschhoek Wine Tram

The Franschhoek Wine Tram hop-on hop-off tour is one of the best ways to discover the true essence of the Franschhoek Valley. Skukuza Golf Club is a magnificent 9-hole (18-tee) course situated in the worldrenowned Kruger National Park on the outskirts of Skukuza rest camp. The rich wildlife sanctuary surrounding the golf course is home to the Big Five, a huge variety of birds and countless animals, which all conspire to provide their visitors with a harmonious close-to-nature golfing experience. Their course is a Par 72, and is 5950m (6450 yards) for men and 5059m (5480 yards) for women. Since the course is not fenced-in, uninvited spectators are a common sight, hippo, impala, warthog and baboons to mention but a few. The course offers the pleasure of challenge and adventure.
